Dear Friends,

On February 4<sup>th</sup>, the General Council of John Calvin Presbytery met in retreat at Trinity Presbyterian Church in Springfield. We spent the day with Carol McDonald, Executive Emerita, Synod of Lincoln Trails. She had done a visioning retreat with General Council a few years ago when Susan Rosenbaum was retiring. This time, she led the retreat as we, your General Council, discerned the way forward for JCP in light of the departure of Melana Scruggs.

For the last several months, Malinda Spencer has been serving in the capacity of a solo presbyter in a system designed to have two presbyters. Beth Kick has been our Acting Stated Clerk, a position which absorbed part of the Governance Presbyter position. The General Council wanted to think in depth about what JCP needs at this point. Do we continue with the two presbyter model or do we combine the position?

We began with a look at what we do well as a presbytery, what we can do better, and who we want to be. The council crafted a guiding statement that reads as follows.

"John Calvin Presbytery is a community of Christ followers in the midst of a changing world. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are called to inspire and equip congregations and leaders to be extravagant and hopeful ambassadors of the reign of God."

General Council then discussed what this means in terms of staffing for John Calvin Presbytery.

The consensus of the council was that it is a more fiscally conservative and mission focused move to have one presbyter and a stated clerk. This will mean that the committees of the Presbytery will be able to have a more active role in the running of the Presbytery. This is a reflection of our call to inspire and equip leaders in their role in proclaiming the reign of God.

The General Council working with the Administrative Ministries Council is crafting a just compensation package for both positions based on monies already allocated. The councils are also crafting job descriptions that follow our guiding principles as well as the mission of JCP and the PC(USA).

We are excited about our future. JCP has remained a strong Reformed presence in a geography that is strongly in the grip of other theologies. We are working to maintain this strength and use the Presbytery's resources in the most wise manner.

We will share more about this in the coming weeks. We do want to invite you to the February 29th Presbytery meeting. We will be engaging in one of the things we do best-worshiping the God who created, redeemed and sustains us. We will be learning about how we further the reign of God by protecting vulnerable populations within our congregations. And we will be doing the business that God has entrusted to us as a connectional church.

**PULPIT SUPPLY** for a minister leading worship and preaching for a congregation as a visiting minister should ordinarily receive \$100.00, plus the IRS approved mileage amount per vouchered mile (2019 IRS rate \$0.58 per mile). Pulpit Supply is \$100.00 with the understanding that is only if one (1) service is to be prepared. It was approved by COM that if two (2) services are required the honorarium would be \$150.00. If overnight lodging is required, motel and meals should be provided at the church's expense. Honorarium for moderating a session is \$50 plus the IRS approved mileage rate per vouchered mile.
